23rd NTU INVITATIONAL SHOOT (NIS 2022)

Dear Club Managers, Coaches, and Teachers-In-Charge,

Happy New Year!

The NTU Sport Shooting Club and NIS 2022 Executive Committee are pleased to invite your Organisation to participate in the 23rd NTU Invitational Shoot (NIS 2022).

Since its inception in 1999, NTU Invitational Shoot is an event endorsed by the Singapore Shooting Association and is an official event within its calendar.

Our objective is to promote shooting sport as well as to instill a sense of sportsmanship and encourage active pursuit of sporting excellence.

EVENT DETAILS

10m Air Pistol and 10m Air Rifle event in mixed format will be held for NIS2022 — physical format at SAFRA or virtual format in your respective school's air weapons range or SAFRA.

We will try to slot in at least 1 team/event for each school for the physical format, prioritising the first team indicated in the registration form. The remaining slots will subsequently be filled at the discretion of the Executive Committee.

A map of the area and nearby public transport options to SAFRA Yishun Country Club can be found [here](#). Similar to previous years, SIUS Ascor Electronic Targets will be used for scoring purposes.

Initial detailing for the physical event will be announced after all registrations have been processed within 5 working days of the deadline.

For the athletes competing in their respective school's air weapons range, coaches are to be present at all times to ensure that safety protocols are followed, as well as to maintain the integrity of the competition.

Only scores recorded for the **physical format** will be endorsed by SSA for selection shoots. Scores recorded during the virtual format will **not** be endorsed by SSA. (Please state special reasons for participating in physical format (eg. Intention to send for NYT selection), if any. We will try our best to allocate a slot in physical format for the respective participant, subjected to availability.)

Do note that there might be last minute changes and/or cancellation of the events due to measures imposed for COVID-19.

INFORMATION FOR VIRTUAL EVENT

We have obtained approval to allow participants to shoot at the SAFRA Indoor Air Weapons Range if they satisfy any of the following conditions:

- They are a valid member of the SAFRA Shooting Club
- For non-members, schools can book a maximum of 5 lanes per detail, at a fee of \$15 per lane, per detail.
- Coaches of all athletes who opt to shoot at the SAFRA Indoor Air Weapons Range (for members and non-members of the SAFRA Shooting Club) are required to be present throughout the shoot to ensure that all safety protocols are adhered to.

All bookings are to be arranged directly with SAFRA by the participants and all fees are to be borne by the participants. For non-shooting club members, do make arrangements with SAFRA 3 working days in advance. Do note that lane bookings are subjected to availability.

On a case by case basis, if there are schools interested in competing in NIS2022 but unable to shoot within the designated competition period with a valid reason, arrangements can be made with NIS Organizing committee to shoot at an earlier period, but only a 14 day window for competition period will be allowed.

Targets

Participants are allowed to shoot on either:

A. Numbered paper targets distributed by the NIS Organizing Committee

Paper targets will subsequently be submitted for scoring (see Cards Collection and Submission section for details).

or

B. SIUS Ascor Electronic Targets at SAFRA Yishun

Participants are required to indicate on the registration form the day and timing that they aim to shoot, and subsequently the electronic target score print-out with the corresponding date and timing will be submitted (see Electronic Target Print-outs Submission section for details).

Target Cards Collection and Submission

Cards Collection

Participants will be able to collect the numbered paper targets at designated collection points. Details are as follows:

Dates: 13th to 19th February 2022

Time: To be arranged with each school after registration

Locations: NTU; and Various MRT stations
(Jurong East MRT, Outram Park MRT, Bugis MRT, Serangoon MRT and Paya Lebar MRT, or other MRT stations which will be arranged with each school after registration)

Upon receipt of the numbered target cards, a form will be signed on site by both the school representative and NIS 2022 Organising Committee member. Further details on the collection of paper targets will be sent out to the participants/ school representatives on a later date.

Cards Submission

The first card of each athlete is to be properly labelled with the **participant's full name, school, event and category**, and placed in order in a bundle and secured with rubber bands. Bundles of each team are to be wrapped in a single plastic bag. All paper targets are to be stored in a secure bag and submitted in person at designated collection points. Details are as follows:

Dates: 7^h to 13th March 2022

Time: To be arranged with each school after registration

Locations: NTU; and Various MRT stations
(Jurong East MRT, Outram Park MRT, Bugis MRT, Serangoon MRT and Paya Lebar MRT, or other MRT stations which will be arranged with each school after registration)

Upon receipt of the shot target cards, a form will be signed on site by both the school representative and NIS 2022 Organising Committee member. Further details on the submission of paper targets will be sent out to the participants/ school representatives on a later date.

Electronic Target Print-outs Submission

Print-outs are to be properly labelled with the **participant's full name, school, event and category** before being submitted into a Collection Box that will be placed in Yishun Safra.

Upon receipt of the electronic target print-outs, a confirmation email will be sent to the participants.

NOTE: All Target Cards and Electronic Target Print-outs are to be received by the NIS 2022 Organising Committee by 13th March 2022, time 2359. No late submissions without a valid reason will be accepted, and the final decision rests with the NIS 2022 Organising Committee.

INFORMATION FOR PHYSICAL EVENT

SAFE MANAGEMENT MEASURES

Safe management measures are to be strictly abided through the course of the competition.

- Mask are to be kept **ON** at all times, including during shoots.
- No more than 50 people are allowed to be in the range at any point of time.
- No cross-mixing of participants between different details.
- Only groups of 5 are allowed (coaches included).
- Distancing of 3m between groups, 2m between one another in the same bubble.
- No spectators are allowed for the competition.
- There will be no prize presentation.
- All participants are to report to their designated holding area before being directed to their allocated zone.
- All participants are to be fully vaccinated and beyond 12 years old.
- Participants are to report to the venue no earlier than one hour before the designated start time to avoid denial.
- Participants may dry fire at designated areas, subjected to availability.
- Signing of result slip is no longer required at the end of the match.
- Each competing participant will also be assigned to a seat in the main range spectator's gallery to rest or store their equipment during the span of their competition.
- Participants who have completed their match, are expected to remain at their assigned seat in the gallery and stand ready to vacate their equipment from the firing point upon announcement.
- Participants are to vacate the range as requested. Strictly no loitering in the range or overstaying.
- Team coaches and managers will be allocated to the first row of seats in the gallery, free seating. Alternate seating arrangement applies.
- Participants must follow the designated entry and exit points. Please refer to signage at SAFRA IAWR.

EVENTS

There are 20 Competition Events classified under the following 5 Categories:

CATEGORY	Eligible Competitors	Age Group*
A	Polytechnics, JCs, IP Schools (Year 5 & 6)	17 – 19
B	Secondary 3 – 5	15 – 17
C	Secondary 1 and Secondary 2	13 – 14
Open	All athletes, including Universities	-
SDSC	Athletes from Singapore Disability Sports Council	-

*Age is based on year of birth

All athletes are eligible to participate for the Open Category Events. Schools which have applied under Categories A, B and C may also apply for the Open Category Events.

NOTE: All participants are to be fully vaccinated and beyond 12 years old. (Refer to Safe Management Measures)

Schools with **Integrated Programme** may enter Teams representing the **A, B or C Categories** separately. Any athlete registered in multiple categories will not be considered.

Registration fees will apply separately for each Event (see COMPETITION FEES & PAYMENT METHODS). Scores for each event will only be valid in the respective category in which they were obtained.

REGISTRATION AS A TEAM / INDIVIDUAL

A **Team** shall consist of 3 athletes. An athlete may apply for an event as an **Individual**, if the athlete is not a member of any team participating in the respective Event.

Apart from team ranking, scores obtained by each team member will also be entered for individual ranking together with individual participants with the respective event.

NOTE: Each athlete is only allowed to represent one organisation throughout the entire competition.

COMPETITION FORMAT

The Chief Range Officer will call athletes to the firing line 5 minutes before Preparation & Sighting Time. The timing for each event is allocated as follows:

Electronic Scoring System	Preparation & Sighting (Unlimited shots)	15 minutes
	Air Pistol/Rifle (60 Competition shots)	1 hour 15 minutes
Paper Targets	Preparation & Sighting (Unlimited shots)	15 minutes
	Air Pistol/Rifle (60 Competition shots)	1 hour 30 minutes

NOTE:

- i. A music playlist created by the NIS 2022 Organising Committee will be sent to all participants. Only the playlist from the NIS 2022 Organising Committee should be used or otherwise, no audio is to be played at all.
- ii. No Sighting Shots are allowed once Preparation and Sighting Time has ended. (*refer to vii. and viii. for exceptions*)
- iii. For paper targets, only one shot is to be shot on each card. As per paper target rules in the ISSF Rulebook, in the event where multiple shots were shot on the same card, subsequent cards are to be left blank.
- iv. Decimal scoring will be implemented for all Air Rifle Events.
- v. Dry firing is allowed.
- vi. There will be no Shoot-offs or Finals.
- vii. If an athlete is interrupted for more than 5 minutes through no fault of his own, time extension is given except for lane changes or gun repairs, such that the time left from the last valid shot is granted for the remaining unfinished shots.
- viii. Sighting is allowed for any lane change or after gun repair using the competition time.
- ix. For the virtual event, representing teachers are to write in formally to NIS 2022 to any situation where there is deviation from normal competition time in honour of the oath of sportsmanship. A coach and a teacher must sign off and submit all paper rolls/target cards involved. These reasons will be accepted on a case by case basis, and the final decision rests with the NIS 2022 Organising Committee.

WEAPONS & EQUIPMENT

Athletes are to:

- i. Prepare their air weapons, ammunition and other equipment for the competition. Items may be loaned from SAFRA Shooting Club at prevailing rates and availability;
- ii. Arrange for their own transport & security clearances;
- iii. Ensure that ALL safety considerations are met while at the event. Movement of air weapons are restricted to and from the Indoor Air Weapons Range and pre-arranged transport;
- iv. Adheres to the Safe Management Measures stated in <https://singaporeshooting.org/portal/safe-management-measures-for-the-sport-of-shooting/> when conducting their respective shooting activities (both at SAFRA Shooting Club or their remote venues) to prevent the spread of COVID-19 virus.)

The NIS Executive Committee will designate a temporary holding area for air weapons during the event. Kindly note that for all events, safety flags must be inserted in all air weapons at all times except when authorisation is given.

RULES & REGULATIONS

All events will be conducted in accordance with the International Shooting Sports Federation (ISSF) Official Statutes Rules and Regulations, Edition 2020. Please refer [here](#).

TRIGGER CHECK

For pistol shooters attending the physical event, trigger checks will only be conducted after each detail for the top **8** athletes in the respective details.

Trigger weight failure will result in immediate disqualification. A trigger weight will be made available in the main range for each athlete's own testing, please be reminded; the outcome from such self-testing does not have any bearing.

TIE-BREAKING

For all Air Rifle events:

Ties will be broken by:

- i. The highest score of the last ten-shot series working backward by 10-shot series in decimal scoring until the tie is broken;
- ii. If any ties remain, decimal scores would be compared on a shot-by-shot basis beginning with the last shot, then the next last shot, etc.

For all Air Pistol events:

Ties will be broken by:

- i. The highest number of inner tens;
- ii. The highest score of the last ten-shot series working backward by 10-shot series in full ring scoring (not inner tens or decimals) until the tie is broken;
- iii. If any ties remain, scores will be compared on a shot-by-shot basis using inner tens (i.e. an inner ten outranks a 10 that is not an inner ten) beginning with the last shot, then the next last shot, etc.

MEALS

No meals will be provided during the course of the entire event.

AWARDS

Medals will be awarded to the top 3 ranked Teams and Individuals for all events. Rankings and awards for the 2 formats will be considered separately.

There will be **no challenge trophy**.

REGISTRATION

Participants **must** fulfill one of the following conditions:

1. A member of SSA Constituent Clubs;
2. A student member of MOE School/ Polytechnic/ University Shooting Clubs.
3. An athlete from Singapore Disability Sports Council

Participants who do not meet the above criteria may proceed with registration, subject to approval from the NIS Executive Committee.

Registration may only be done via completion of the attached Registration Form. **No other modes of application will be accepted.**

As of 1 September 2019, under compliance with the Personal Data Protection Act (PDPA), we will no longer require the NRIC of athletes registering for the competition. We now require the athlete's full name as per NRIC, and his/her birth year. **The Executive Committee reserves the right to check the NRIC of any athlete if any discrepancies are suspected and reject any athlete who registers under a name not displayed in their NRIC.**

All detailing requests must be made at the end of the registration form. Requests made elsewhere outside the form will not be entertained. Completed Registration Forms may be sent to the Executive Committee at ssc-niscommittee@e.ntu.edu.sg.

Ensure that there is no more than ONE application. All queries and/or modifications to previous applications should be directed to the above email address. A confirmation email will be sent to you within 4 working days.

Registration will be open from **3rd January 2022 to 31st January 2022.**

There is no limit to the number of participants. We will try to slot in at least 1 team/event for each school for the physical format, prioritising the first team indicated in the registration form. The remaining slots will subsequently be filled at the discretion of the Executive Committee.

Modifications to any Athlete's detailing may be done without penalty during the initial detailing review period (**until 16th February 2022, 2359**). All organisations are required to carefully verify their entries after release of initial detailing. **The Executive Committee shall not be held liable for any registration related discrepancies after the release of final detailing as well as during the course of the entire event.**

Amendment requests made after 16th February 2022 will be subjected to an additional charge of S\$50.00/- per change (see COMPETITION FEES & PAYMENT METHODS).

The Executive Committee reserves the right to reject any applications and amend the terms and conditions without prior notice.

Payments must be made by:

Organisations are not allowed to pay for each registered athlete individually. Please compile and pay in a single amount.

Athletes who do not turn up for their registered event without prior notification will be charged the full registration fee.

Additional fees are applicable as follows:

A *Late Registration Fee of \$10.00/- per participant per event* will apply after the registration deadline.

An *Amendment Fee of \$50.00/- per change* will apply after initial detailing review period.

A *Late Payment Penalty Fee of \$50.00/- per week* will apply for payments made beyond the deadlines for the respective payment method/s.
