## 24<sup>th</sup> NTU INVITATIONAL SHOOT (NIS 2023)

Dear Club Managers, Coaches, and Teachers-In-Charge,

Happy New Year!

The NTU Sport Shooting Club and NIS 2023 Executive Committee are pleased to invite your Organisation to participate in the 24th NTU Invitational Shoot (NIS 2023).

Since its inception in 1999, NTU Invitational Shoot is an event endorsed by the Singapore Shooting Association and is an official event within its calendar.

Our objective is to promote shooting sport as well as to instil a sense of sportsmanship and encourage active pursuit of sporting excellence.

## EVENTS

There are 20 Competition Events classified under the following 5 Categories:

CATEGORY	Eligible Competitors	Age Group
A	Junior Colleges, Polytechnics, and ITE Colleges	17 - 19
B	Secondary 3 – 5	15 - 17
C	Secondary 1 and Secondary 2	13 - 14
Open	All Shooters	-
SDSC	Shooters from Singapore Disability Sports Council	-

All athletes are eligible to participate for the Open Category Events. Schools which have applied under Categories A, B and C may also apply for the Open Category Events.

Schools with Integrated Programme may enter Teams representing the A, B or C Categories separately. Any athlete registered in multiple categories will not be considered.

Registration fees will apply separately for each Event (see COMPETITION FEES & PAYMENT METHODS). Scores for each event will only be valid in the respective category in which they were obtained.

## REGISTRATION AS A TEAM / INDIVIDUAL

A Team shall consist of 3 athletes. Each athlete is only allowed to represent one organisation throughout the entire competition.

An athlete may apply for an event as an Individual, if the athlete is not a member of any team participating in the respective Event.

Apart from team ranking, scores obtained by each team member will also be entered for individual ranking together with individual participants with the respective event.

## COMPETITION FORMAT

The Chief Range Officer will call athletes to the firing line 15 minutes before Preparation & Sighting Time. The timing for each event is allocated as follows:

EVENT (MEN/WOMEN)	TIME ALLOTTED
Preparation & Sighting (Unlimited shots)	15 minutes
Air Pistol/Rifle	1 hour 15 minutes

Please note that decimal scoring will be implemented for all Air Rifle Events. Dry firing is allowed.

There will be no Shoot-offs or Finals.

## WEAPONS & EQUIPMENT

Athletes are to:

- i. Prepare their air weapons, ammunitions and other equipment for the competition. Items may be loaned from SAFRA Shooting Club at prevailing rates and availability;
- ii. Arrange for their own transport & security clearances;
- iii. Ensure that ALL safety considerations are met while at the event. Movement of air weapons are restricted to and from the Indoor Air Weapons Range and pre-arranged transport;

The NIS Executive Committee has designated a temporary holding area for air weapons during the event. Kindly note that for all events, safety flags must be inserted in all air weapons at all times except when authorisation is given.

All pistol shooters will have to undergo a trigger weight check before their match. They will be allowed to do a trigger weight check one detail before their competition.

## REPORTING TIME

Athletes are to report to the registration booth at the entrance of the SAFRA Range at least 15 minutes before the start of their respective detail. Athletes are to confirm that their details and personal particulars are accurate.

## DRY FIRING

Athletes will not be allowed to dry fire within the main range outside of the firing bay.

## RULES & REGULATIONS

All events will be conducted in accordance the MOE Rules and Regulations for National School Games Shooting 2022. Please refer [here](#).

## TIE-BREAKING

### For all Air Rifle events:

Ties will be broken by:

- i. The highest score of the last ten-shot series working backward by 10-shot series in decimal scoring until the tie is broken;
- ii. If any ties remain, decimal scores would be compared on a shot-by-shot basis beginning with the last shot, then the next last shot, etc.

### For all Air Pistol events:

Ties will be broken by:

- i. The highest number of inner tens;
- ii. The highest score of the last ten-shot series working backward by 10-shot series in full ring scoring (not inner tens or decimals) until the tie is broken;
- iii. If any ties remain, scores will be compared on a shot-by-shot basis using inner tens (i.e. an inner ten outranks a 10 that is not an inner ten) beginning with the last shot, then the next last shot, etc.

## PROTESTS

All athletes are not allowed to protest during match time.

### MOE Schools

In accordance to NSG Rules and Regulations, protests can only be made by Teachers-in-Charge or Principals during match and designated protest time.

### Other SSA Constituent Clubs

Coaches will be allowed to make protests during match. Athletes and coach can protest during designated protest time.

## MEALS

Do note that no meals will be provided during the course of the entire event.

## AWARDS

Medals will be awarded to the overall top 3 ranked Teams and Individuals for all Events.

Medals are also awarded to the top 3 ranked Teams in each Zone (North, South, East, West).

Challenge Trophies will be awarded to 2 main categories, Open and Schools Categories. Categories A, B and C are considered under Schools Category.

Challenge Trophy Points shall only be awarded to Organisations which participate in at least ONE Team Event of the respective Categories.

The Challenge Trophy Point Allocation System is as follows:

## REGISTRATION

Note that participants must fulfil one of the following conditions:

1. A member of SSA Constituent Clubs;
2. A student member of MOE School/ Polytechnic/ University Shooting Clubs.
3. An athlete from Singapore Disability Sports Council

Participants who do not meet the above criteria may proceed with registration subject to approval from the NIS Executive Committee.

Registration may only be done via completion of the attached Registration Form. No other modes of application will be accepted.

All detailing requests must be made at the end of the registration form. Requests made elsewhere outside the form will not be entertained. Completed Registration Forms may be sent to the Executive Committee at [ssc-niscommittee@e.ntu.edu.sg](mailto:ssc-niscommittee@e.ntu.edu.sg).

Ensure that there is no more than ONE application. All queries and/or modifications to previous applications should be directed to the above email address. A confirmation email will be sent to you within 5 working days.

Registration will be open from 2<sup>nd</sup> Jan 2023 to 30<sup>th</sup> Jan 2023.

There is no limit to the number of participants. Priority will be given to the first Team & Individual entry for each Event & Category. The remaining slots will subsequently be filled on a first-come-first-served basis at the discretion of the Executive Committee.

Modifications to any Athlete's detailing may be done without penalty during the initial detailing review period (until 13<sup>th</sup> February 2023). All organisations are required to carefully verify their entries after release of initial detailing. The Executive Committee shall not be held liable for any registration related discrepancies after the release of final detailing as well as during the course of the entire event.

Amendment requests made after **13<sup>th</sup> February 2023** will be subjected to an additional charge of S\$50.00/- per change (see COMPETITION FEES & PAYMENT METHODS).

The Executive Committee reserves the right to reject any applications and amend the terms and conditions without prior notice.

An Amendment Fee of **\$50.00/- per change** will apply after initial detailing review period.

A Late Payment Penalty Fee of **\$50.00/- per week** will apply for payments made beyond the deadlines for the respective payment method/s.
