

What are the training hours like?

Mon-Fri with 2 time slots of 2 hrs each, minimum time required is 2 times a week.

Do I need to purchase any equipment?

What is provided?

When can we begin training?

Due to the current COVID-19 situation, we would only be able to begin trials/training in September 2020.

How heavy is the rifle/pistol?

The pistol is 900g & the rifle is 4kg

What is the difference between rifle and pistol?

Pistol is shot one handed and in the Olympic style with body squared forwards and arm raised perpendicular to the body.

Rifle is shot with two hands and in the Olympic style.

Rifle shooters need to wear a special suit and shoes for extra support.

Targets for pistol are larger than that of rifle.

What's the difference between Varsity Training Team and Experience shoot?

Varsity Training Team is the team which will be training to represent NTU in any competitions, due to the limited amount of equipment we have, space within the team is limited.

Fun shoot will be a monthly shoot where any interested student can experience shooting in a safe, fun environment. However, due to the current COVID-19 situation, we would only be continuing to run fun shoots when Singapore enters phase 3 and dependent on NTU's approval.

Can we train at SAFRA Yishun?
